Home care provider WellBe Senior Medical names first president

WellBe Senior Medical announced Tuesday it appointed veteran healthcare executive Dr. Michael Le as the company’s first president.

Le joined the Chicago-based healthcare provider last month and will play a crucial role as WellBe Senior Medical expands into more states, CEO Dr. Jeff Kang said in an email.

“Dr. Le is uniquely qualified to propel our dedicated teams and comprehensive services to the next level, ensuring we deliver the highest quality of care to our patients,” Kang said.

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Le was previously chief medical officer at WelBeHealth PACE, a Menlo Park, California-based company that operates Programs of All-Inclusive Care for the Elderly across California. Before that, he co-founded and was chief medical officer at Landmark Health, a provider of home-based healthcare services to older adults that is a subsidiary of UnitedHealth Group’s Optum Health.

WellBe Senior Medical partners with Medicare Advantage insurers to provide home-based healthcare services to older adults through capitated risk arrangements. The company operates in nine states.
